




## COVID Filtering Instructions for Notify


MX Notify can now send you a notification when one of your attributed patients has tested positive for COVID-19. The COVID-19 notifications will be displayed in the same location as the hospital admit and discharge notifications. If you would like to display the COVID-19 notifications and the hospital event notifications as two separate worklists, use these instructions to create and save both filters outlined here.

To create a list of only COVID-19 notifications, please follow these steps:


1. At the top of the screen, click on **Add Filter**.




2. Select **Event Type** from the dropdown menu.




### 3. Select **Equals** from the dropdown menu.



### 4. Select **R01: Test Result** from the dropdown menu.




### 5. The filter will be displayed on the screen.





- To save the results enter a name in the **Customer Filter Name** box, under **Add Filter**. MX recommends naming the filter “COVID-19+ Results.”




- The filter will now be saved to your **Custom Filters**.




To exclude all COVID-19 notifications from the list of hospital event notifications, please follow these steps:

- At the top of the screen, click on **Add Filter**.



## 2. Select **Event Type** from the dropdown menu.





## 3. Select **Does Not Equal** from the dropdown menu.






4. Select **R01: Test Result** from the dropdown menu.
