




COVID Filtering Instructions for Notify


MX Notify can now send you a notification when one of your attributed patients has tested positive for COVID-19. The COVID-19 lab test result notifications will be displayed in the same location as the hospital admit and discharge notifications. There are multiple worklists that can be created according to your needs.

To create a list of COVID-19 lab test result notifications, please follow these steps:


1. At the top of the screen, click on **Add Filter**.




2. Select **Event Type** from the dropdown menu.




3. Select **Equals** from the dropdown menu.



4. Select **R01: Test Result** from the dropdown menu.




5. The filter will be displayed on the screen.






- To save the results enter a name in the **Customer Filter Name** box, under **Add Filter**. MX recommends naming the filter “COVID-19+ Results.”




- The filter will now be saved to your **Custom Filters**.




To create a list of notifications from hospital events and exclude COVID-19 lab test results, please follow these steps:

- At the top of the screen, click on **Add Filter**.




2. Select **Event Type** from the dropdown menu.








4. Select **R01: Test Result** from the dropdown menu.




5. The filter will be displayed on the screen.

7. The filter will now be saved to your **Custom Filters**.




**Note: This will exclude COVID-19 lab results, however if a patient has an admit or discharge with a COVID-19 positive diagnosis, then the COVID diagnosis will be displayed with all other hospital events.*




To create a list that includes COVID-19 notifications only (i.e., lab test results and COVID-19 hospital events), please follow these steps:


1. At the top of the screen, click on **Add Filter**.



2. Select **Diagnosis Description** from the dropdown menu.




3. Select **Contains** from the dropdown menu.
